Literacy Communication and Language (Speaking and listening, reading and writing) 	Read a book with an adult every night	Practice saying good morning/ good afternoon so you can greet your teachers.	Go to the library and borrow a book. Bring it in to share with the class
Mathematics (Counting, recognising and using numbers, calculation, shapes and measures) 	Find three squares in your house.	Collect three lids or bottle tops. Bring them in to show your teacher.	Bring in a photo of you next to your door number.
Understanding The World (People and places, the world, our community, ICT and the environment) 	Draw a picture of a family celebration	Go for a nature walk. Can you find some leaves or conkers to bring to school?	Bring in a photo of you and your family
Expressive Arts and Design (Art, music, movement and dance, role-play, design and technology) 	Sing a nursery rhyme with your family	Build a tower using blocks , legs or junk boxes.how high can you build?	Bring in your favourite toy to show your teacher.
Physical (Being active, co-ordination, control and movement, making healthy choices) 	Help your child to be independent by learning how to take off and put on their coat.	Help your child to be independent by being able to wash their hands with soap and water after going to the toilet	Draw around your hand colour each finger a different colour.
